Welcome

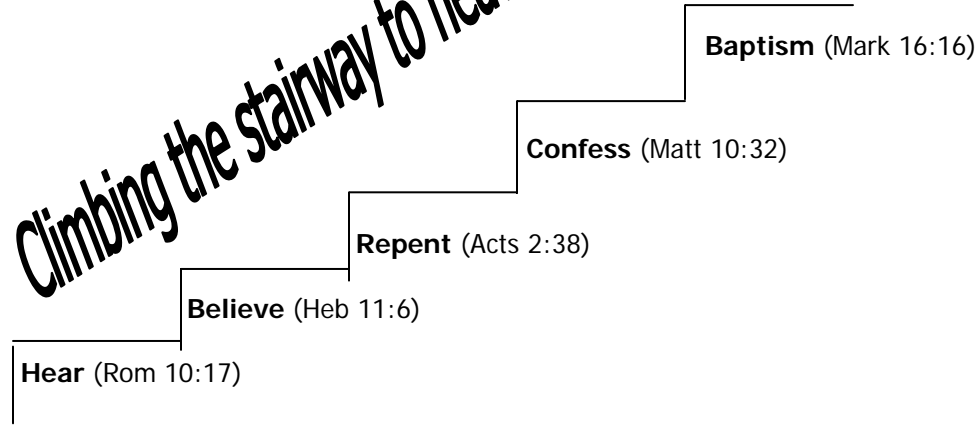

Is just knowing God is near me.

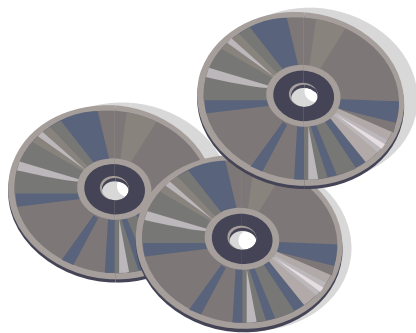
Our lives are in God's loving

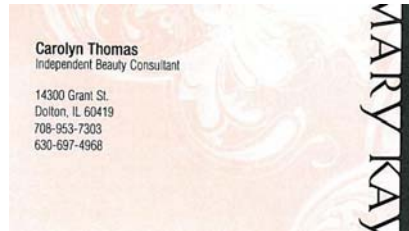
